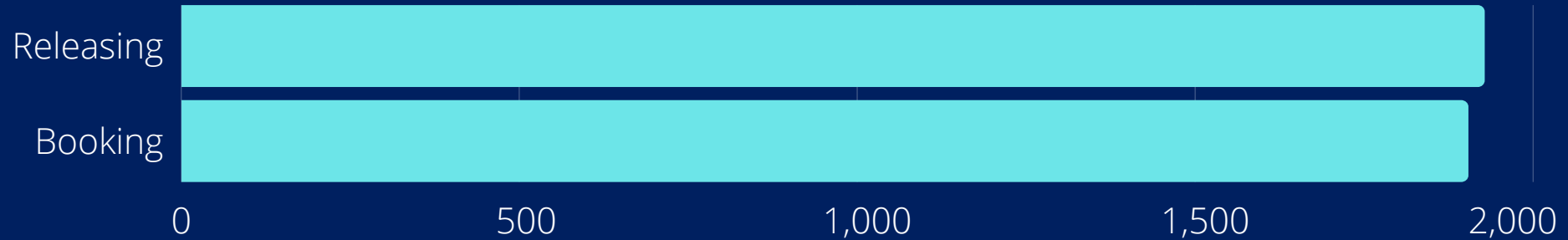


EMPLOYEE UPDATE

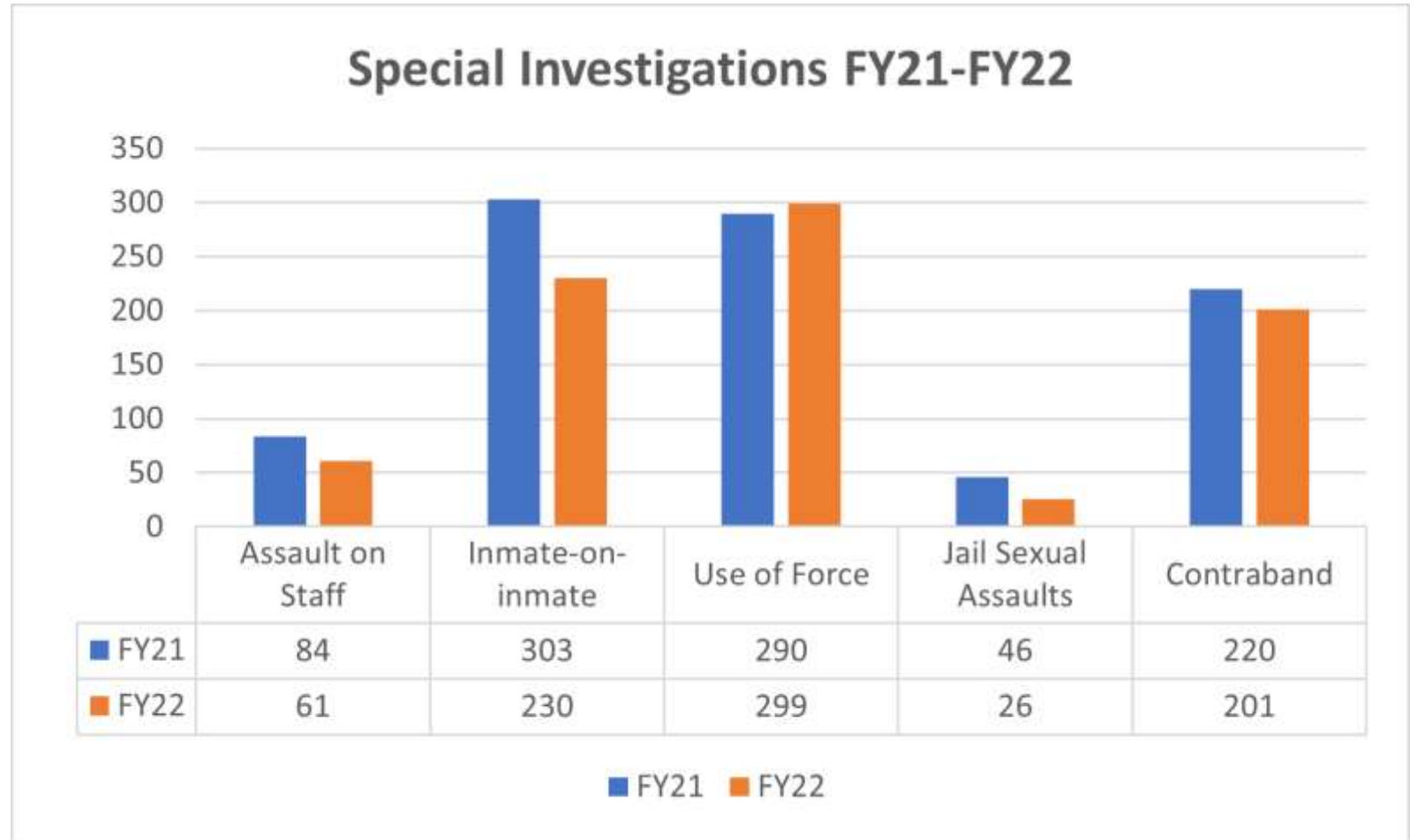

FY22 FAST TRACK BOOKING

- The Fast Track booking procedure implemented in February 2022 makes it easier to book and release individuals with a warrant and a posted bond. Fastrack booking is done on the unsecure side of the jail and takes less than 30 minutes. This frees up space in the secure booking area. During FY22, OCDC booked in 397 individuals using Fast Track.

EMPLOYEE RAISE PROPOSAL



- 8.5% C.O.L.A. raise -- Same as all county employees, retroactive to July 1, 2022
- \$500/mo. parity pay for Detention Officer staff

SUICIDE PREVENTION EFFORTS

- 4 scheduled sessions for staff during October
- Prevention posters around facility
- Updated and enhanced pre-service and in-service training

Staff will undergo suicide prevention seminar with Turnkey psychiatrist
