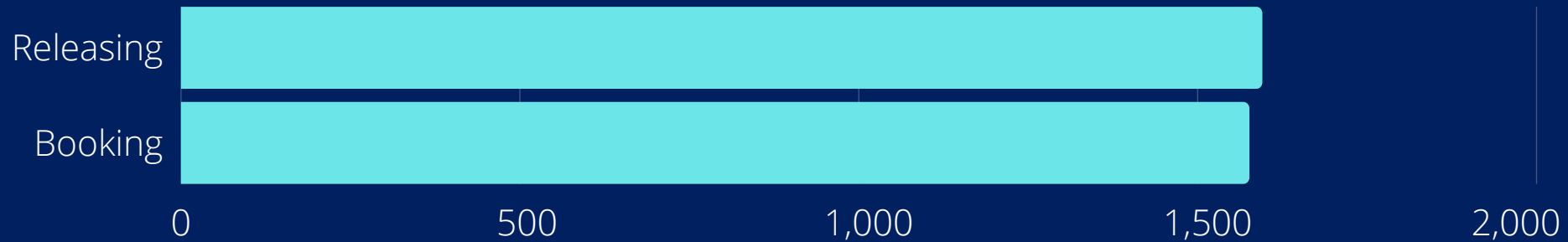


EMPLOYEE UPDATE

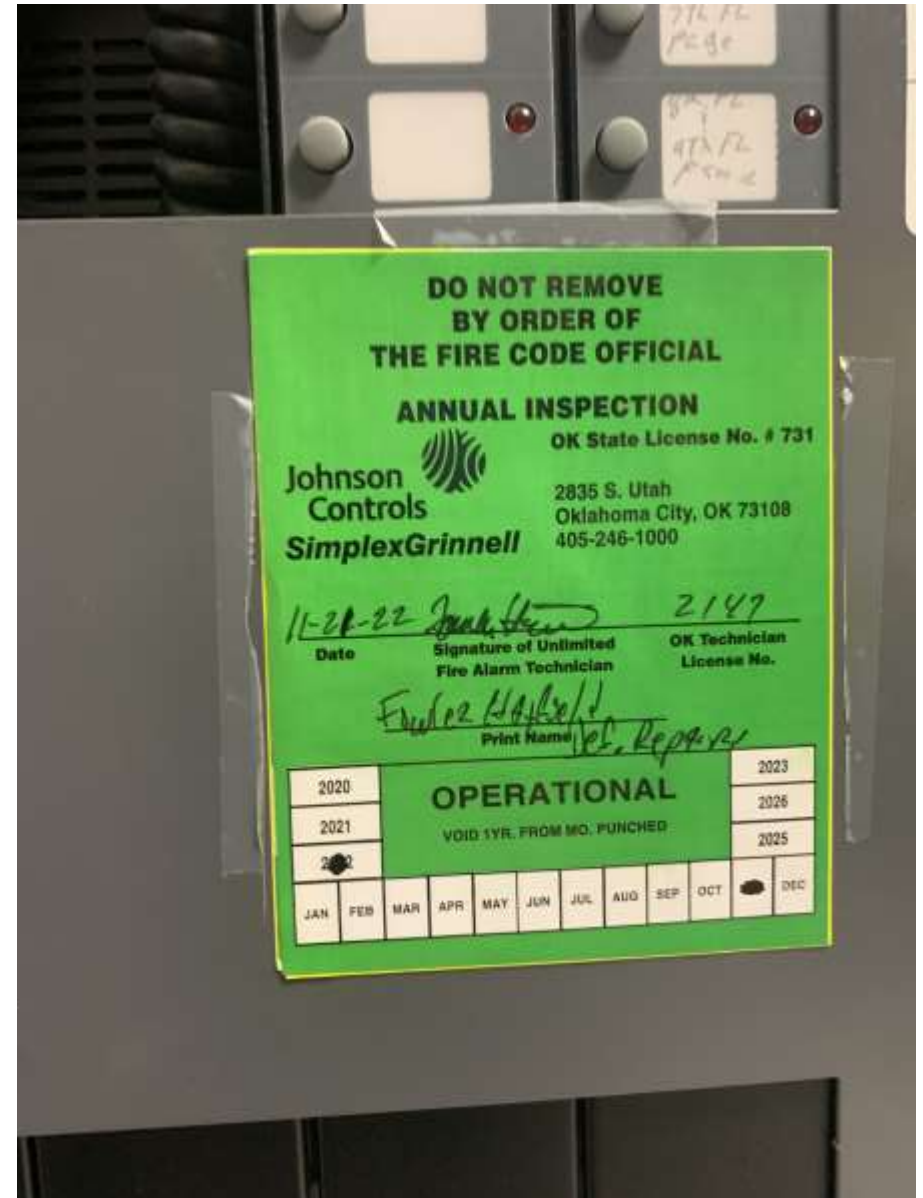

Johnsons Controls - Green tagged fire system

- 2nd year in a row
- Meet all federal fire safety requirements



OUT OF CELL TIME INITIATIVE

Leadership staff have developed a plan to increase out of cell time. The biggest hindrance in the past is number of employees.

- ❑ Holding town hall meetings with detainees
- ❑ Sharing vision and getting “buy-in” from detainees



CUSTODY PROTECT – DETAINEE HEALTH SENSOR

Outfit 100 detainees have been provided sensor bands. This technology will increase the safety of detainees. The sensors monitor vital signs and signal to medical staff when a problem occurs.

- ❑ 100 sensor bracelets - \$199,500
- ❑ Sensors will be administered and controlled by medical staff
