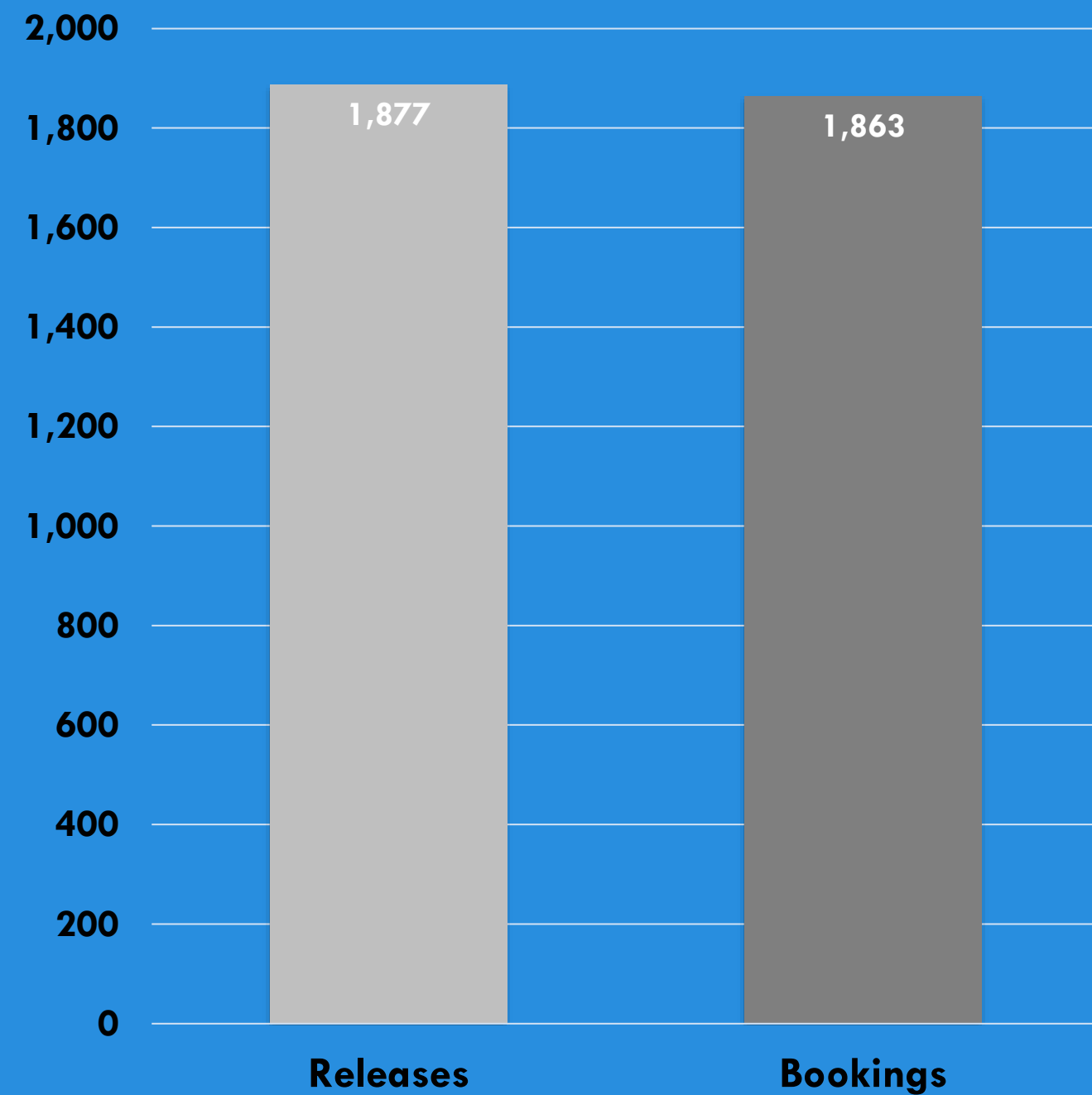

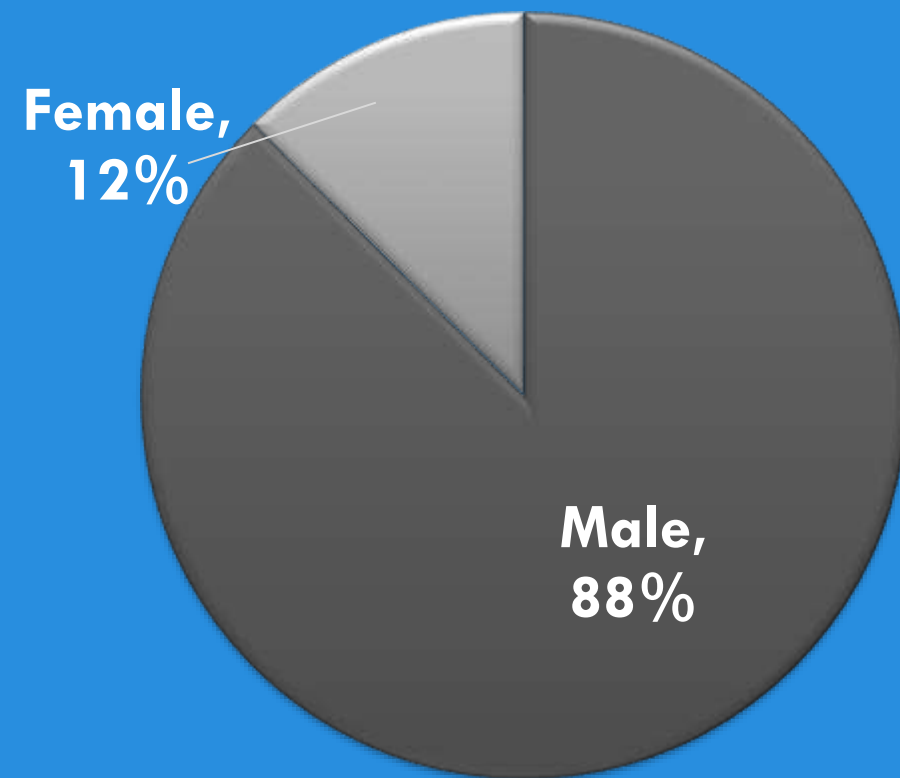

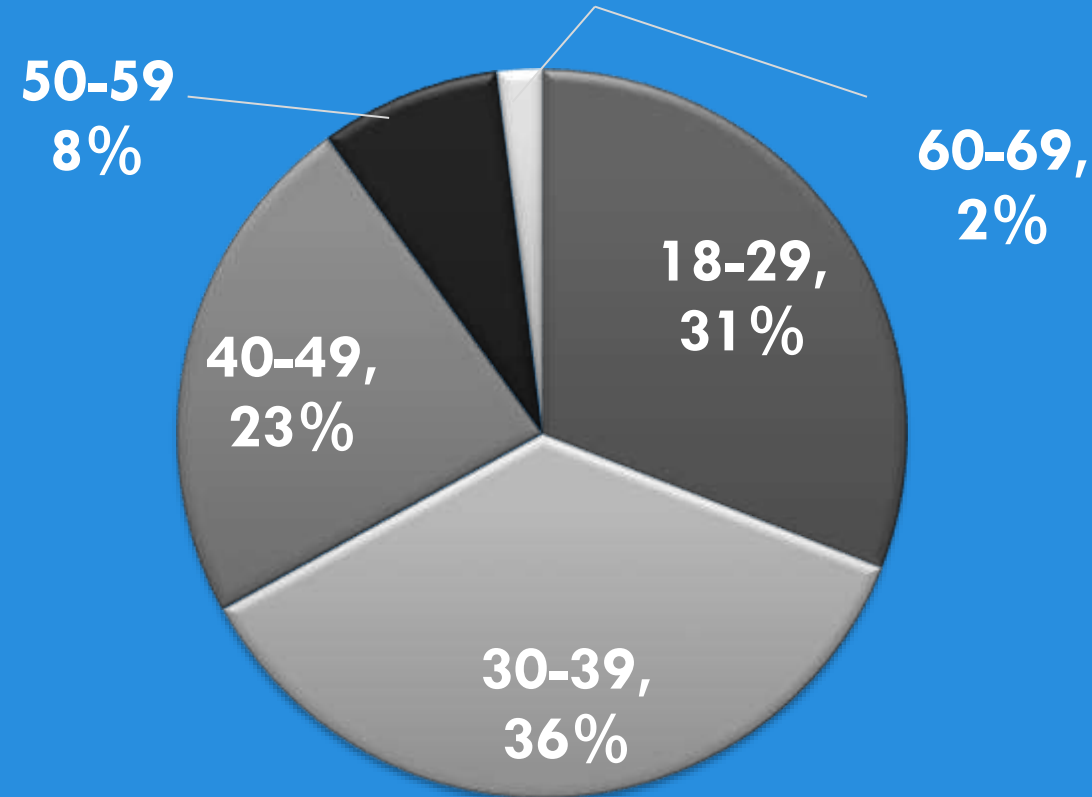


Admission Demographics

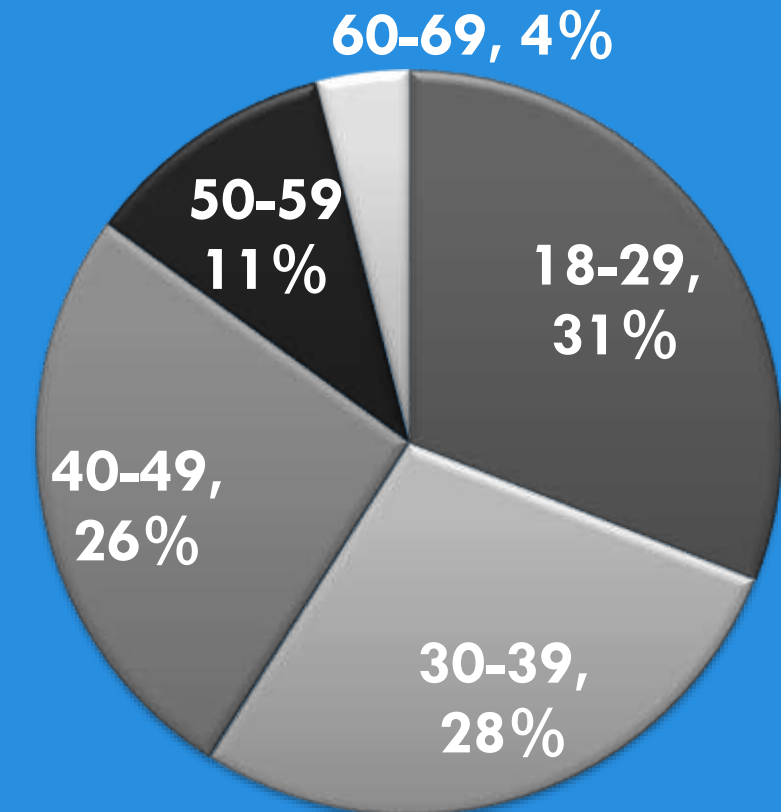
AVG. POPULATION BY SEX

MALE AGE



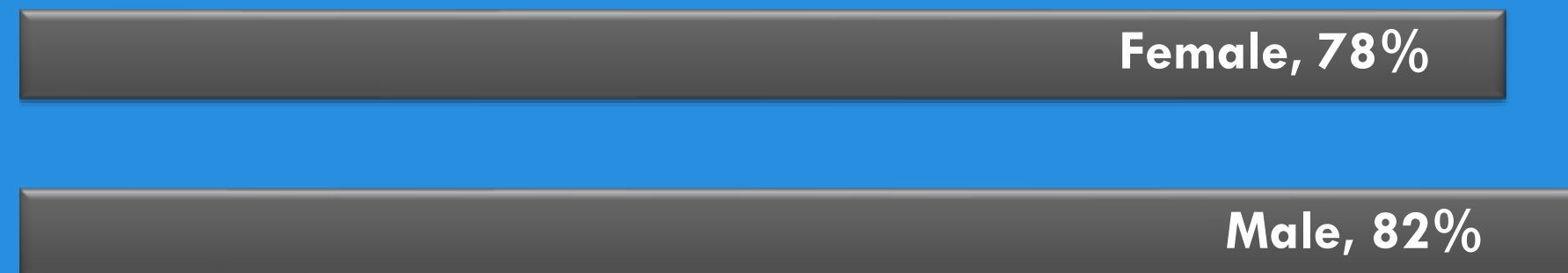
