Deficit

- OUTLOOK: \$1.6m deficit at end of FY
- Received Tx Refund of \$638,000
- Awaiting disbursement of approved ARPA
Reimbursement: \$1,100,085.85

- Case 3 – Dementia

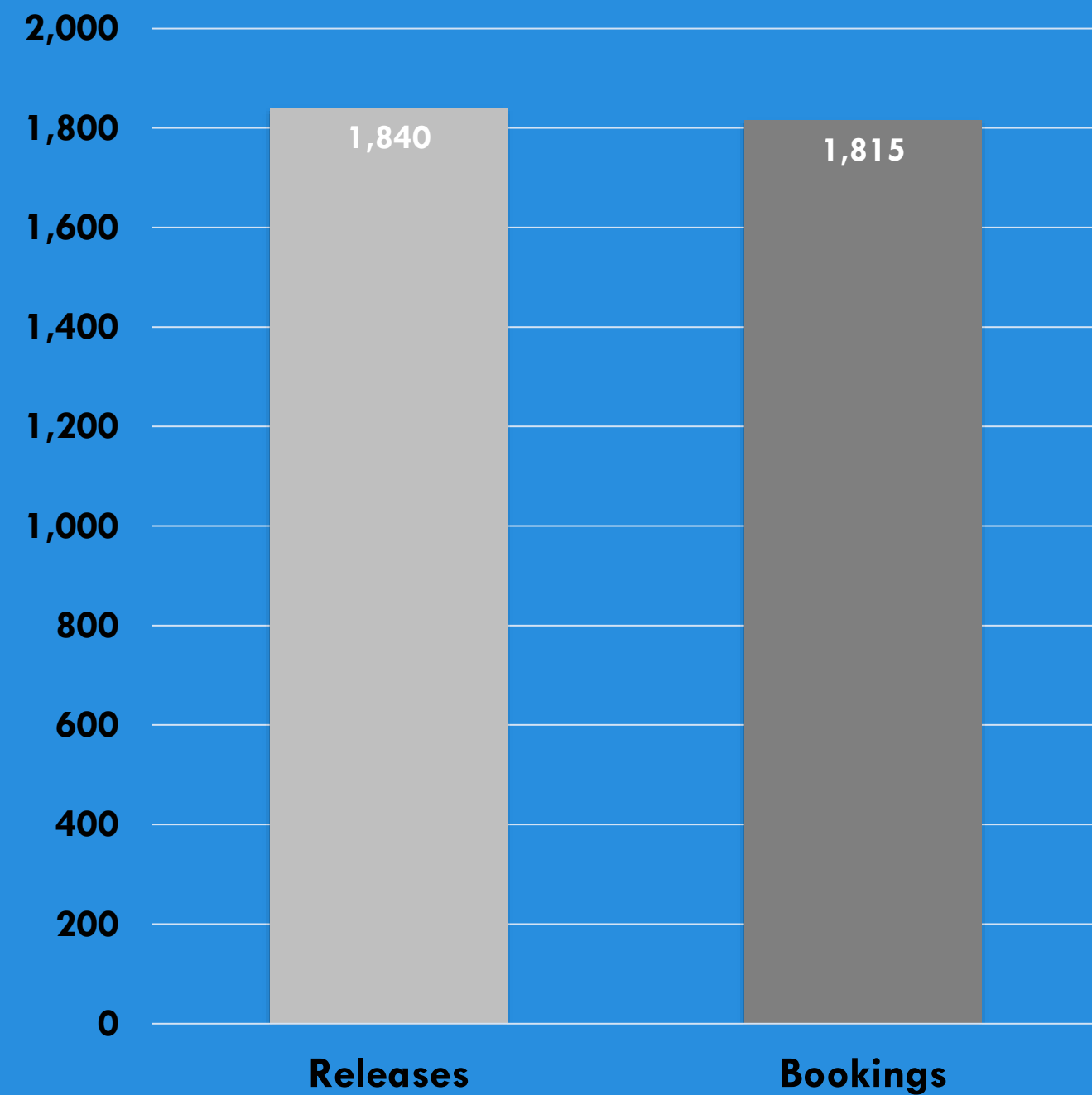

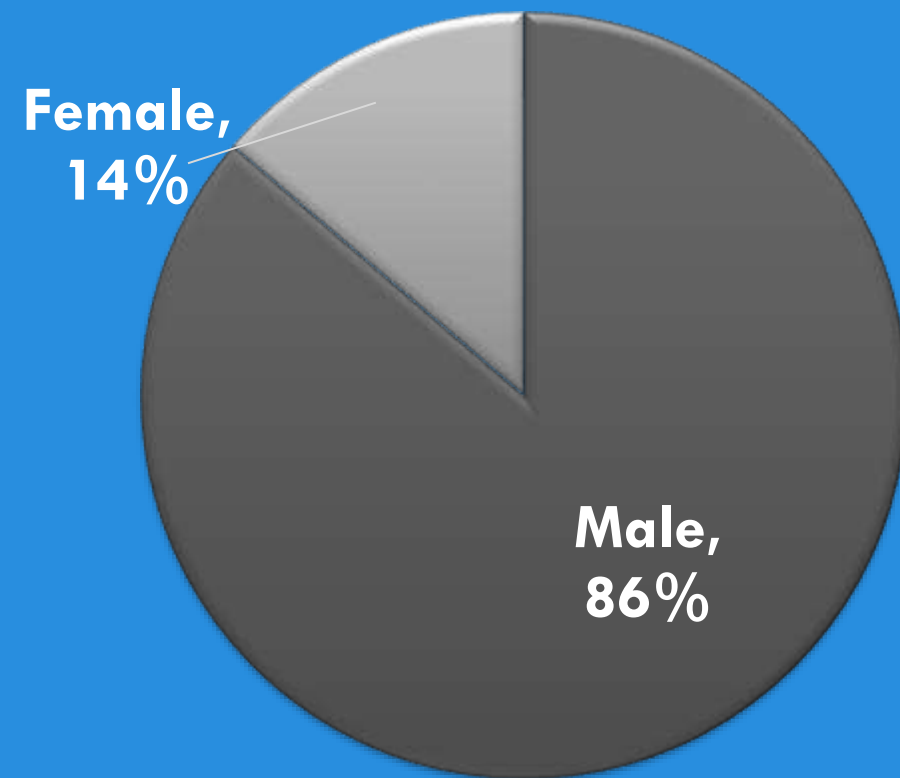

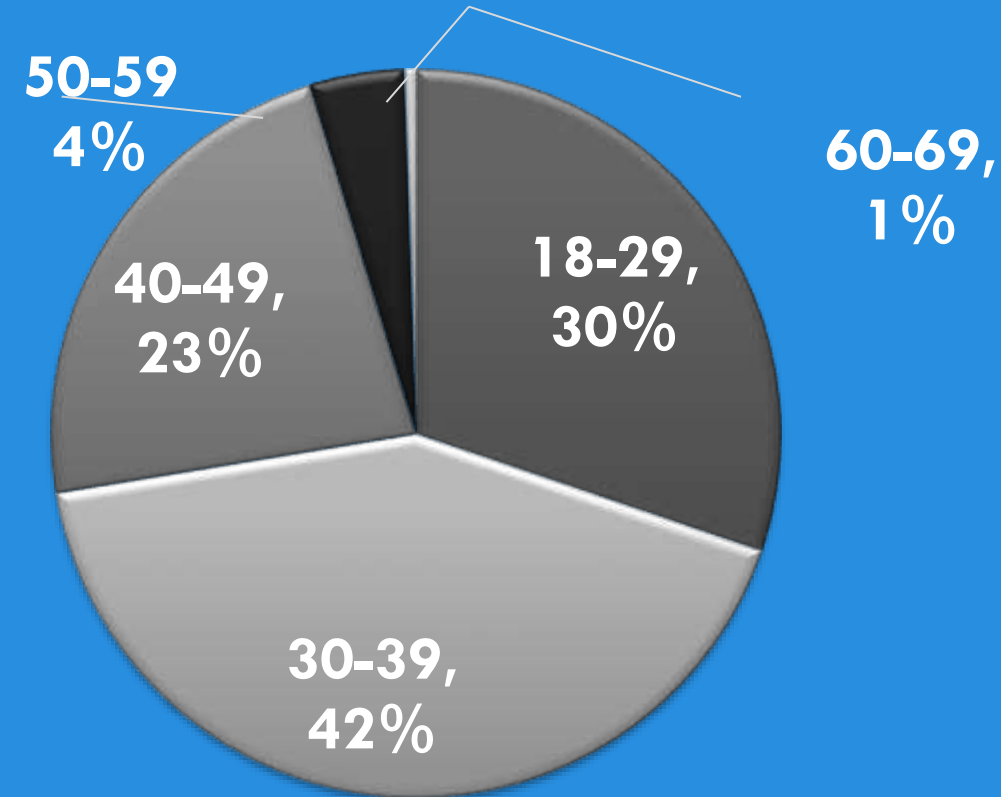


Admission Demographics

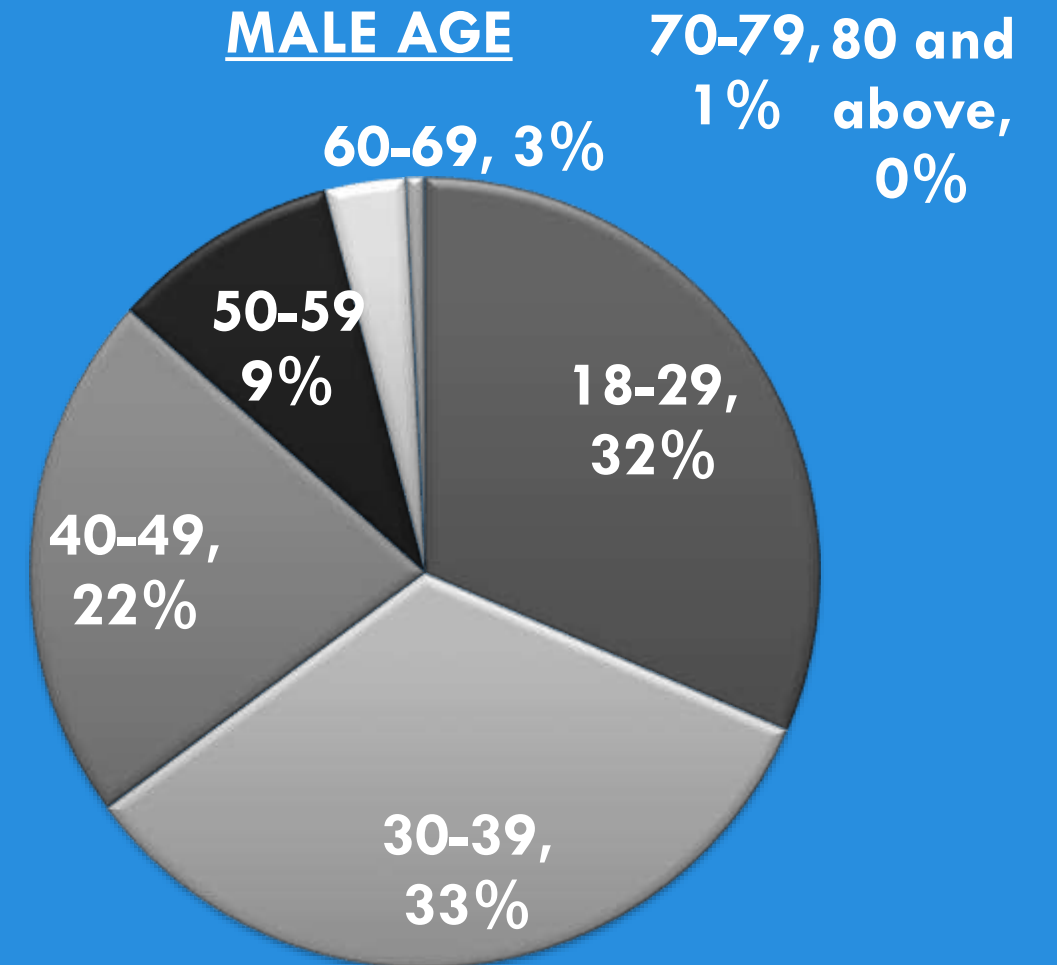
AVG. POPULATION BY SEX



FEMALE AGE



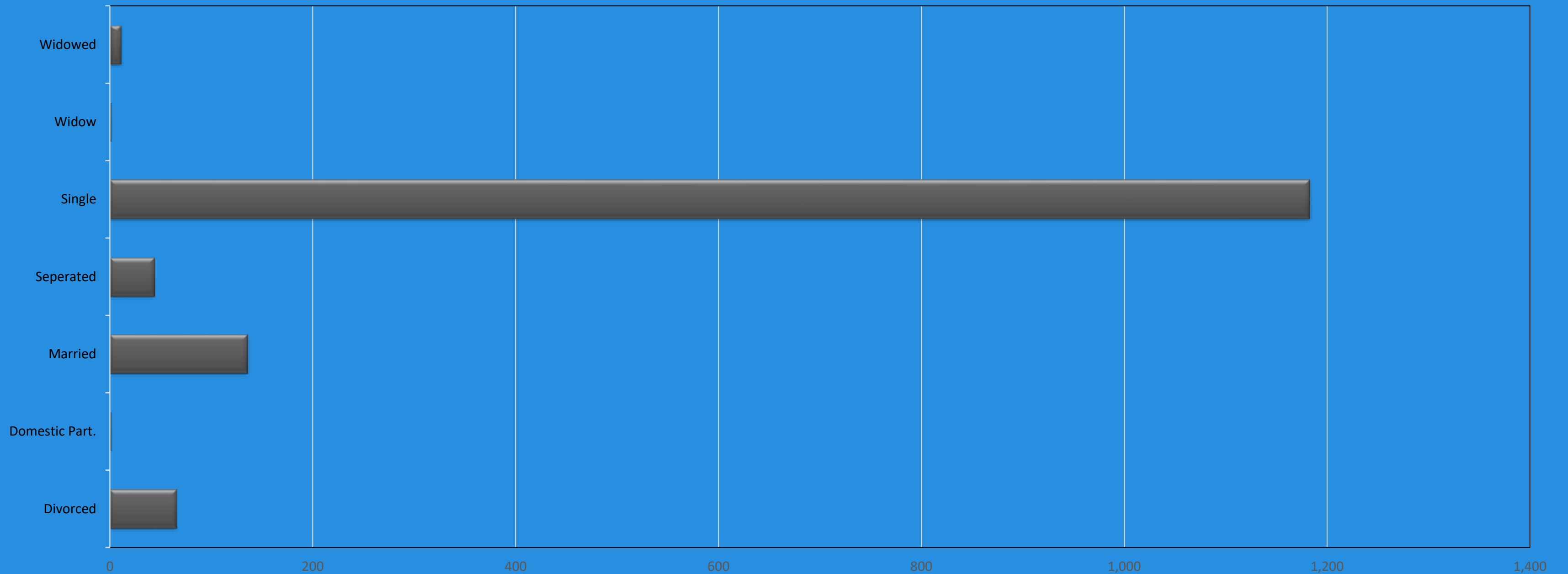
MALE AGE

Marital Status



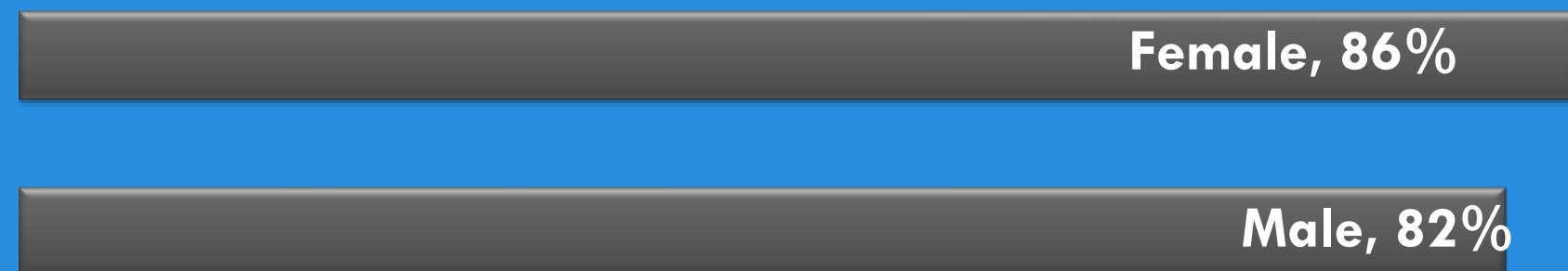

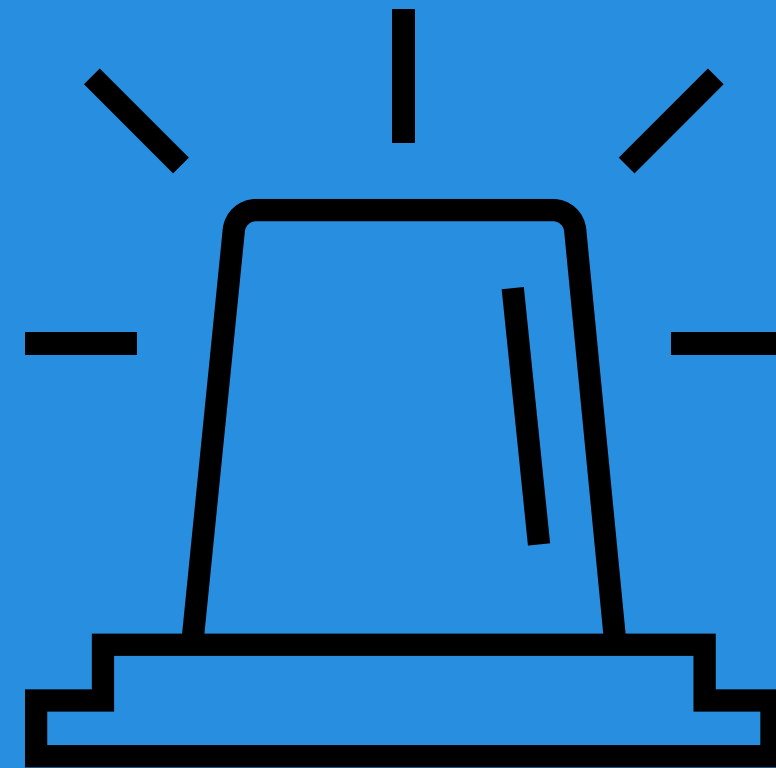
POPULATION BY RECIDIVISM PERCENTAGE

Trauma Informed Response Training

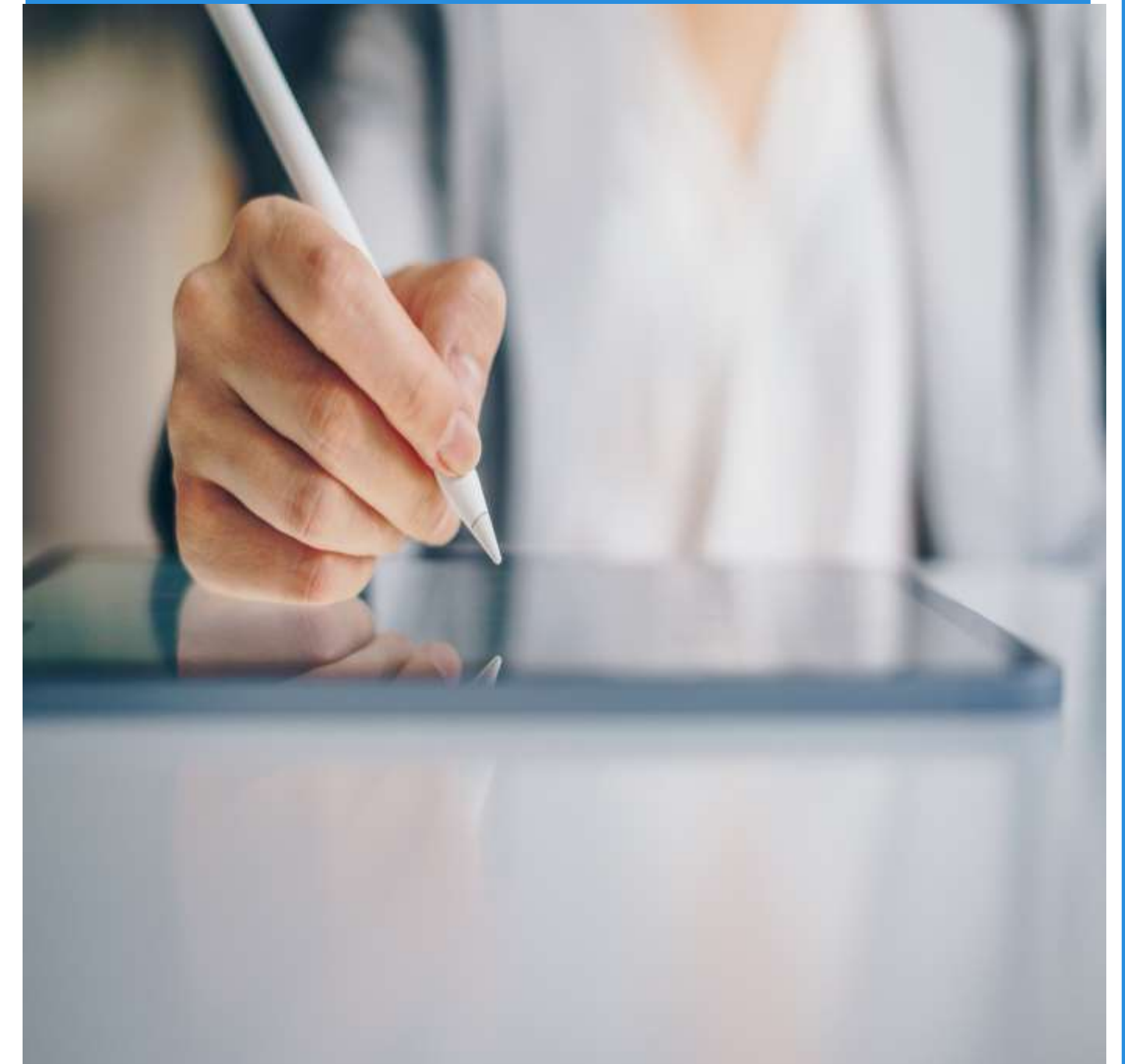
- Coordination with Mental Health Assoc.
